Note: Citizens of countries requiring Visa do not need to present a Visa if they have the following documents:

- a) A document certifying permanent residence in Canada, USA, Japan, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, or any of the countries of the Schengen Area.
- b) Valid and in force Visa of the United States of America.
- c) APEC Business Traveller Card (ABTC) adopted by Mexico.
- d) Certificate accrediting the visitor as a crewmember of the arriving aircraft.
- e) Book Sea, if a crewmember of the vessel arriving to a Mexican port in international voyage. If the crewmember arrives by air to enrol in a vessel anchored in a national port, they will have to submit additionally to the sea book, a document proving the enrolment, the data from the vessel and the Mexican port where they are located.
