

IWRA World Water Envoys at the XVII World Water Congress – Terms and Conditions

Description

For the XVII World Water Congress, IWRA wants to hear different voices and stories from around the world. In particular, we are looking for representatives from the "next generation" to showcase at the Congress the issues they face in their communities when it comes to Water Security.. Selected representatives will be called "World Water Envoys".

Activities during the Congress

During the opening ceremony of the Congress, each of the World Water Envoys will have the opportunity to talk about one particular water security challenge faced in his or her community and the impacts that the challenge has on every day life. The World Water Envoys will then have the opportunity to discuss the challenges and possible solutions in more detail over the following days with experts attending the Congress. Finally, the World Water Envoys will be asked to summarise in the Closing Ceremony what they have learned over the week, and what connections they have made that might help their communities to overcome water security challenges.

Application Process

To apply, candidates for selection as a World Water Envoy must provide the following:

- A video recording of up to 2 minutes made on a phone or laptop introducing the water security situation faced by the local community and explaining what the problem is and how it is impacting the community.
- One high-resolution digital photo that best illustrates the impact of poor water security on the community. The candidate should be the author of the photo.
- A application form, available on the website, that includes all requested information as well as consent for IWRA to use any submitted images.

All of this material should be sent via email before November 30th 2019 to congress@iwra.org.

Next Steps

Once selected, the candidates for World Water Envoy will be given a deadline by which to send confirmation to IWRA of their ability to travel to the Congress, as well as evidence of a valid passport. After the confirmation is received by IWRA, flights and accommodations for the selected World Water Envoys will be arranged.

Awards and Benefits

World Water Envoys will be funded to come to Korea, including:

• One economy round-trip ticket to Daegu, Korea



- Accommodation including breakfast from May 10th to 16th (6 nights)
- Travel insurance for the duration of the trip
- Registration to the Congress, including all lunches, a ticket to the gala dinner, and participation in the field trip
- One year free membership to IWRA

Terms and conditions

- Awards and benefits provided through this program are not transferable to any other individual, and cannot be exchanged for another award, benefit, or monetary value
- Travel and accommodation provided through this program must take place to coincide with the XVII World Water Congress
- World Water Envoy candidates must be 18 years old before May 10th 2020, and must have both a valid passport and any required visa for the period of travel
- World Water Envoys must be willing to be recorded and have their names, images, videos and water security challenges used to promote both the Congress and IWRA
- World Water Envoys must waive any and all claims they may have against IWRA or any other person that may arise as a result of travel to and participation in the World Water Congress.
